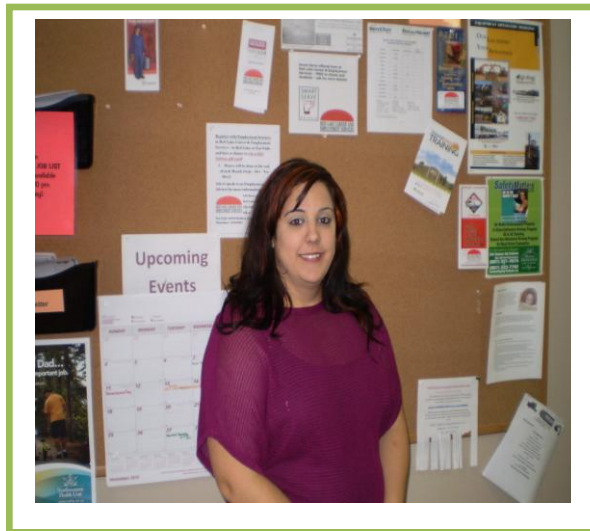


The Employment Edge

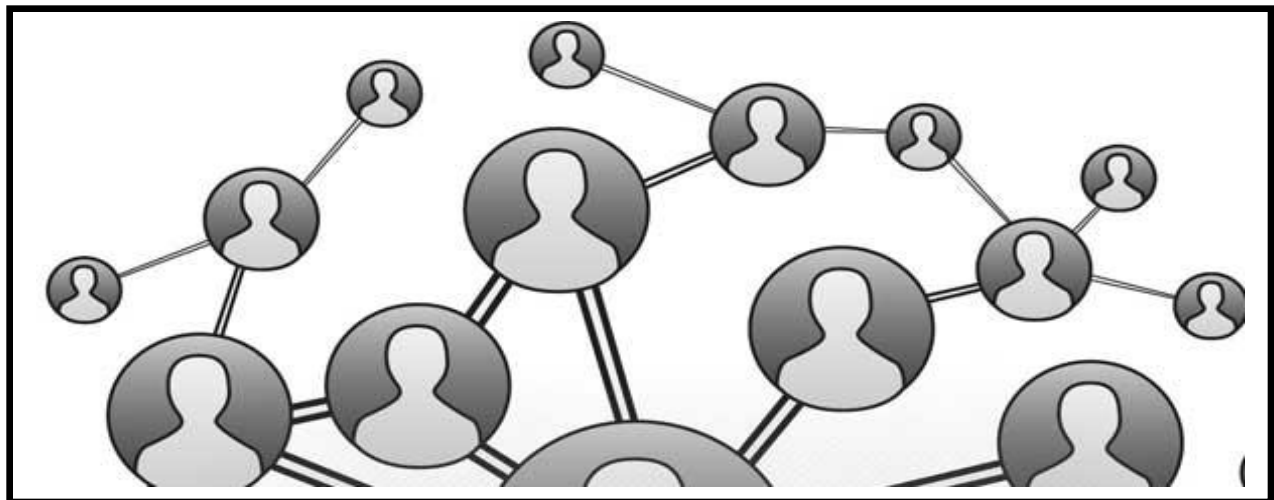
